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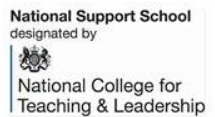
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**Learning From Home**

Please find below details of your child's learning from home tasks for this week.

Sounds buttons. Each sound (grapheme) will have a button. Single sounds (phonemes) have a dot, like <b>b</b> and <b>e</b>.</p> <p><i>spade</i> ..... Two letters together that make one sound (a digraph), like <b>ph</b> and <b>sh</b> have a line underneath.</p> <p><i>dolphin</i> ..... Remember that the Phase 4 blends like <b>sp</b> are still two sounds (phonemes) blending. They are not digraphs. Can you write down four i-e words and draw the sound buttons on?</p> <p><b>Activity Two:</b> Play Picnic on Pluto (see link to the left), Phase 5 and select the split digraph i-e sounds to play.</p> <p><b>Activity Three:</b> Complete the split digraph i-e learning sheets. How many can you do?</p> <p><b>Bonus activity:</b> tricky word snakes and ladders! Who will win this game? Make sure that you read each word out loud when you land on it.</p>

You can listen and read at the same time using the soundcloud link.</p> <p><b>Activity 3:</b> Complete the activities on pages 5 – 7: 'Talk about the story', 'who said what?' and 'Quiz time'.</p>



<p><b>Writing</b></p>	<p>We are learning to use accurate punctuation.</p>	<p>Your writing tasks are all linked to the fantastic Talk for Writing booklet, Sayeeda the Pirate Princess. We have chosen some activities for you to do, but please feel free to explore the many other activities as well. I wonder if any of you will be able to solve the riddles on page 15-16 or make your own pirate hat or treasure map?</p>	<p><b>Activity 1:</b> Page 10 of the booklet, 'Fill your treasure'. Name ten things that could be in your treasure chest.  <b>Activity 2:</b> Page 11, 'Diary writing'. Re-read Sayeeda's diary and help correct her capital letters and full stops. She has been very lazy in her diary writing!  <b>Activity 3:</b> Page 14, 'Storytime'. Use the sentence openers to tell then write your own pirate adventure story about Fergus. Remember to re-read and check your capital letters for names and the beginning of sentences.</p>
