




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



Have you tried or made any of the dishes in this book?</i></p>	<p>Read the text on the separate page and answer the questions about Italy.</p> <div data-bbox="1153 493 1542 1039" style="border: 2px solid red; padding: 10px;"> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Facts About Italy</b></p> <p><b>Where Is Italy?</b> Italy lies in the south-east of Europe and is known as 'bel paese' in Italian meaning 'beautiful country'. It has borders with four other countries: France, Switzerland, Austria and Slovenia which are separated in the north by the Alps.</p> <p>With its distinctive boot shape, Italy is easy to spot on a world map. The peninsula sits in the Mediterranean Sea and as a result, it has a very long coastline (6,722 miles). Italy has over 450 islands, the largest three of which are Sicily, Sardinia and Elba. These are popular holiday destinations due to the Mediterranean climate and stunning landscape.</p> <p>In the south, Italy has three volcanoes: Vesuvius, near Naples; Etna on the island of Sicily and Stromboli off the coast of Italy. Vesuvius is the only European volcano to have erupted in the last 100 years and is considered to be one of the world's most dangerous.</p> <div data-bbox="1185 808 1518 892" style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px;"> <p><b>Did You Know...?</b> The Italian flag (Il Tricolore) has three equally sized vertical stripes which each represent a different virtue:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• the green stripe represents hope,</li> <li>• the white stripe represents faith,</li> <li>• and the red stripe represents charity.</li> </ul> </div> <p><b>Weather in Italy</b> Italy has a typically Mediterranean climate with hot, dry summers and mild winters in the majority of the country. More than 52 million tourists flock to Italy each year and it is a popular summer holiday destination. However, Italy also has popular ski resorts in the mountainous regions to the north which also attracts tourists and holiday makers. Mont Blanc is the highest peak in the north of Italy and measures 4807m high.</p> </div>
