Year Three

TERM FOCUS

This term's topic is The Romans. Children will learn about how the Roman army was organised and re-create some of the formations as Centurion soldiers. A geographical study of Rome will be carried out whilst using map skills to explore the Roman Empire. The life of Boudicca will be studied in English to link to this topic as well as some Latin! Children will learn how life changed in Britain during this period.

In Science the topic of forces and magnets will be explored, developing the children's skills of working scientifically.

In RS the significant times for Jews will also be researched.

READING

Children in Year 3 are expected to read **aloud** for **at least 10 minutes every day**. Hearing a story is also useful to broaden their vocabulary.


It is important for children to reflect on and discuss what they have read to check their understanding. Children will focus on the following skills - vocabulary, inference, prediction, explanation, retrieval and sequencing or summarising to improve their comprehension and understanding of texts.

WRITING

Linked to our Roman topic, Julius Caesar will be studied to continue to develop the children's knowledge of Shakespeare and his plays. The children will no doubt enjoy the drama associated with this study!

High expectations of joined, correctly sized handwriting, the use of accurate punctuation and using conjunctions to join sentences are expected. Ambitious vocabulary is continued to be learnt and applied. This term Year 3 will learn how to measure length and perimeter. Telling the time using digital and analogue clocks will also be learnt and it is really encouraged for this skill to be practised at home too.
