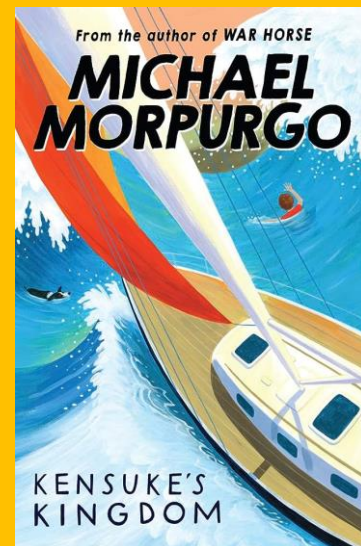


**Reading**
