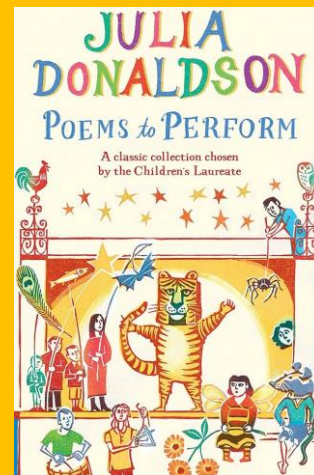
Kindness Challenge

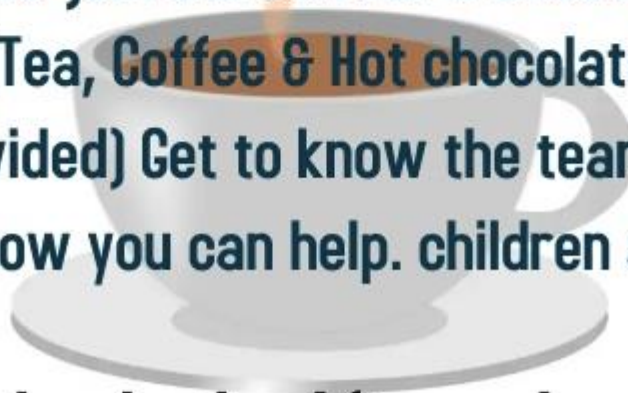
