Dear Year 6 Families,

Year 6 Residential 2024 – Bristol

Thank you in advance for returning the necessary documents for your child to attend the Year 6 residential; the children are starting to get very excited about our trip.

General Information

As the weather can be unpredictable, please ensure that your child has plenty of warm clothes with them including a good waterproof coat with a hood. We will continue with our planned itinerary whatever the weather, so please ensure children have appropriate clothing with them. Wellies and an umbrella have been added to the attached kit list. We have also been reminded that all children must bring a towel with them to the YHA as these are not provided. Money must also be brought into school in a named purse or wallet - please do not bring money in an envelope.

Please can we ensure that the bag the children bring to Bristol is not too large. Ideally, a small, soft bag would be more suitable for the space available on the coach, as you can imagine it is a tight fit with over 60 bags.

For the journey to Bristol, children will need to have the following items with them in a rucksack on the coach, not in their main luggage:

- A waterproof jacket
- A packed lunch - a sandwich, bag of crisps, a piece of fruit, a full re-usable water bottle, one small treat (i.e., a KitKat or small cake). Please put everything in disposable containers and ensure that any food packed does not contain any nuts.

This should be in a rucksack rather than a one shoulder bag as the children will also use this bag to carry their packed lunches and other items during the residential as we walk around Bristol.



Medication

All medication required for the trip , **including Epipens and Inhalers** will need to be provided from home on the morning of the trip. Please note, any medication we hold in school for your child will remain in school.

If your child requires any medication, the medication form (link below) will need to be completed by **Friday 11th October**.

The coach will arrive at school at approximately 8:45am and we plan to leave as soon as we can. Children should arrive at school no earlier than 8:15am and no later than 8:30am, and we ask that an adult brings their child into the hall to be registered; to hand in any medication and their pocket money. We would ask that you leave the hall at 8:45am, in order for us to get the children ready to depart. On return to school on Friday 18th October, the children are expected to return at 4pm. A text will be sent out to confirm our estimated arrival nearer the time.

Updates while we are away

A text will be sent out to let families know that Year 6 have arrived in Bristol. There will then be a daily update in the afternoon/evening to share a small update to explain what the children did each day. This post will be uploaded to Google Classroom with accompanying pictures. If you need to contact Miss Adams or Miss Leney while Year 6 are away, please speak to the office who will be able to pass any messages on. We will not be replying to any messages sent on Google Classroom.
