Black History Month

Through October, we have been celebrating Black History Month, and on Tuesday, all Saxon

children took part in a Big Live Assembly which explored:

- how diverse role-models and figures of influence can inspire children and young people in learning and relationships
- how Black history and cultural diversity values can be embedded into the curriculum and school life

What we pay attention to is what we get more of

The more attention that is given to good behaviour – praising, rewarding, giving privileged responsibility – the more ‘good’ behaviour there will be

ALL CHILDREN NEED ATTENTION

Hugs, praise, rewards = positive attention = positive behaviour.

Criticism, shouting = negative attention = negative behaviour

By the age of 5 years, most children hear 10 ‘DON’T or critical instructions to 1 ‘DO or positive instruction.

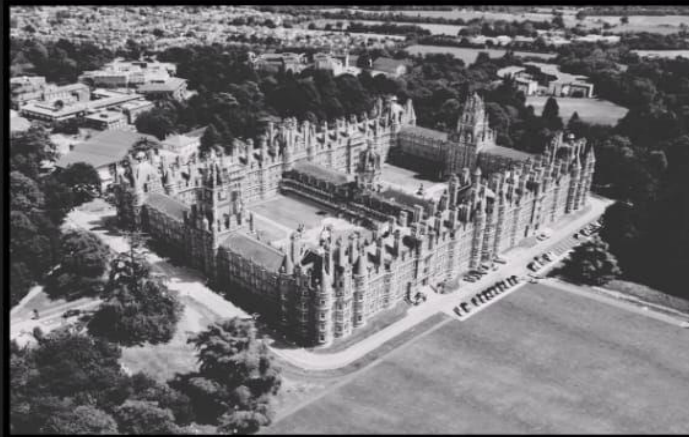
