WEEKLY NURSERY NEWSLETTER

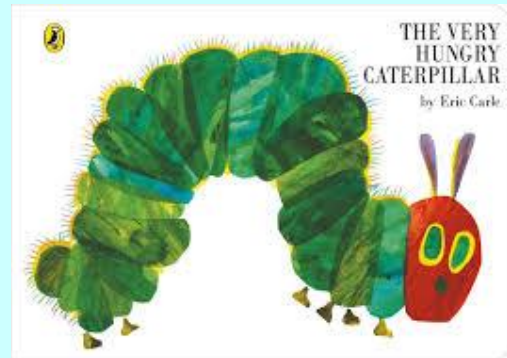
This week the children have been learning about Caterpillars.
